

Timo Korhonen, (b. November 6, 1964 in Rautalampi, Finland) is one of the most versatile proponents on his instrument in the world. He has performed in more than 30 countries, at venues in Berlin, London, Vienna, Paris, Tokyo, Chicago, Toronto, St. Petersburg, Madrid, Buenos Aires, Havana, Los Angeles, Hong Kong among others. He has appeared with orchestras under Esa-Pekka Salonen, Sakari Oramo, Osmo Vänskä, Leif Segerstam, Jukka-Pekka Saraste, Susanna Mälkki, Tuomas Hannikainen, Joseph Swensen, Hannu Lintu and John Storgårds. Korhonen's repertoire includes the entire core repertoire written for his instrument. He has premiered more than 40 new works, and composers such as Magnus Lindberg, Leo Brouwer and Toshio Hosokawa have written works for him. Korhonen records regularly for the Ondine label. His recordings have been acclaimed by critics and have received several awards including celebrated Cannes Classical Award 2003. He is Co-Founder of international Sibelius Guitar-project.
